

Directions to Choate Rosemary Hall

From the north on I-91: Take exit 15. Turn right onto Rt. 68. Turn left at third stoplight onto North Farms Road, which becomes North Elm Street. At Christian Street (5th stop sign), turn left. Go past Art Center and turn left onto Rosemary Lane. Park in front of soccer fields and on roadway. Look for signs for Ruutz-Rees Dining Center and Science Center.

From the north and south: Wilbur Cross Parkway (RT. 15) Take exit 64. Turn right onto Quinnipiac St. Bear left at Wallace Park, cross over R.R. tracks. Go straight through light (Quinnipiac becomes Center St. at this intersection). Turn left at second light (at top of hill) onto North Main St. Turn right at first stop sign onto Christian Street. Go past Art Center and turn left onto Rosemary Lane. Park in front of the soccer fields or on the side of the road. Look for signs for Ruutz-Rees Dining Center (for cocktails and dinner meeting) and the Science Center (for “Life after Fellowship” and Cardiac Care Associates “Meet and Greet.”)

From the south on I-91: Take exit 14. Turn left onto Woodhouse Avenue, go through second light at Center St. (At this point, Woodhouse Avenue becomes East Main St.) At second stop sign turn left onto Christian Street. Turn right onto Rosemary Lane. Park in front of the soccer fields or on the side of the road. Look for signs for Ruutz-Rees Dining Center and Science Center.

From the west (Danbury or Waterbury, CT) on I-84: Take I-691 exit 10. Follow to Wilbur Cross Parkway/I-91 south exit. Follow directions above.

Best route from Boston (northeast of Wallingford, CT): (Drive time: 2 ¼ hours.) Take I-90 (Mass Pike) West to I-84 West (connects in Sturbridge, MA). Take I-84 west to I-91 South (connects in Hartford, CT). Take exit 15. Turn right off the exit onto Route 68. At 3rd traffic light, take a left onto North Farms Road, which becomes North Elm Street. This is a residential, country road. At the 5th stop sign, you will be on the Choate campus, at the intersection of North Elm Street and Christian Street, turn left. Go ¼ mile to Rosemary Lane and turn left. Park along the street or in front of the soccer fields. Look for signs for the Ruutz-Rees Dining Hall (for dinner and cocktails) or the Science Center (for “Life after Fellowship” and Cardiac Care Associates “Meet and Greet.”)

Best route from New York City (southwest of Wallingford, CT). (Drive time: 2 ¼ hours). Take the Merritt Parkway North (Rt. 15). This road changes its name to the Wilbur Cross Parkway/Rte. 15 in Stratford, CT. Take Exit 64. Turn right onto Quinnipiac Street. Bear left at Wallace Park and cross over railroad tracks. Go straight through traffic light. (Note: At this intersection Quinnipiac becomes Center Street.) At top of hill (at second traffic light) turn left onto North Main Street. At the first stop sign, take a right onto Christian Street. Go through intersection at North Elm. Rosemary Lane will be on your left. Park along the street or in front of the soccer fields. Look for signs for the Ruutz-Rees Dining Hall (for dinner and cocktails) or the Science Center (for “Life after Fellowship” and Cardiac Care Associates “Meet and Greet.”)

Alternate Route from New York City. Take I-95 North to I-91 North (connects in New Haven, CT). Take Exit 14. Turn left off exit onto Woodhouse Avenue. Go straight through 2 traffic lights. (Woodhouse becomes Center Street; Center becomes East Main Street.) At 2nd stop sign, turn left onto Christian Street. Turn right for Rosemary Lane. Park in front of soccer fields or on the road. Look for signs for Ruutz-Rees Dining Center and Science Center.
